"Get Hooked on Antique Tractor Pulling"

8 classes for Stock Antique tractors (1985 & older) weighing up to 6,500#.

5 classes: Stock 1985 & older (7,500#-11,500#)

5 classes: Super Antique 1985 & older (4,200#- 6,500#)

NOTE: Track officials may allow continued production models that are newer to pull.

Weigh-in starts about 10:00 AM---Pulling begins about 2:00 PM

Abbreviated rules:

1. All persons entering LRPTA grounds must have paid daily or season gate entry fee.
2. \$15.00 hook charge for each pull – 1 pull per class. Maximum of 2 class entries per tractor.
3. When registering: show your paid daily show admission or season pass to get 1 (one) free hook for 1 (one) tractor during this year's show.
4. Minimum driver age is 12 – If under age 16 or without valid Drivers License, the individual must present written parent or guardian permission. Forms are available in the registration booth.
5. No alcoholic beverages or illegal substances allowed in pulling area before and during pull.
6. Tractor must be in neutral during hook-up and un-hook times.
7. A 1% weight variation is allowed at weigh-in to determine class selection.
8. Tractors will re-weigh just before pulling in their designated class and wait in the paddock for their turn. No weight may be added after scaling or tractor will forfeit all competition for the day.
9. All classes maximum hitch height is 20 inches. All classes must have 18 inches minimum distance from center of rear axle to drawbar pull point. Wheelie bars are recommended.
10. Operator must furnish a pin and heavy-duty twisted clevis with 3 inch or larger opening.
11. **2 wheel** drive tractors only. No rear mounted implements allowed.
12. Cut tires are allowed in Super Antique classes only; dual wheels not allowed.
13. All tractors are to have working brakes.
14. In the interest of safety, engine RPM should not exceed Nebraska Test or manufacturer's specifications by more than 20%.
15. The first puller in each class can accept or reject the pull. An immediate re-pull will occur if this pull is rejected; puller must remain on track for the re-pull. When your tractor leaves the track, your pull is finalized and cannot be disputed.
16. If sled has not traveled more than 50 feet, a re-pull is allowed.
17. Exhibition pulls may be allowed by **Blue Ox Pulling Team** track officials.
18. All pullers are to provide their own Liability insurance.
19. **LAKE REGION THRESHERMEN** cannot be held liable for damages resulting from participation in pulling activities.
20. **BLUE OX PULLING TEAM TRACK OFFICIALS'S DECISIONS ARE FINAL.**

YOUR PULL WILL TERMINATE (be measured) AT THE POINT WHERE:

1. ANY PART OF THE TRACTOR GOES OUT OF BOUNDS.
2. THE FRONT END RISES OVER 15" ABOVE TRACK GROUND LEVEL.

YOU WILL BE AUTOMATICALLY DISQUALIFIED (black flagged) IF:

1. THE OPERATOR RISES OFF THE TRACTOR SEAT.
2. ANY PART FALLS OFF THE TRACTOR DURING YOUR PULL.
3. YOU HEAR OVERSPEED WARNING HORN FOR THE SECOND (2) TIME.
